Sean Anthony Sullivan Declares “Rock and Roll Will Save Us All” with New Album Forged in Michigan

Sullivan’s new record urgently celebrates rock ‘n’ roll’s power to help us escape the grind and feel alive together.

LANSING, MI — 9/29/25 — There’s nothing restrained about Sean Anthony Sullivan’s latest record. *Rock and Roll Will Save Us All* channels the strut of the Stones with the storytelling of Springsteen for an urgent album that refuses to trade the now for later. It’s rock ‘n’ roll unchained. Forged in Michigan, but built for anywhere the music still matters.

In a world of doomscrolling, where music is too often relegated to background noise, *Rock and Roll Will Save Us All* pushes back. The record embraces the present, built for road trips and rock bars, for voices raised together instead of isolated in earbuds, music built to remind us what it feels like to be alive.

“We live in a world hooked on micro dopamine hits, always frantic, the illusion of multitasking,” Sullivan says. “I want to get lost in something. That’s what I’ve always loved about album-oriented rock. Those ‘70s records you drop the needle and just take the ride. That’s the spirit here: a record that plays like a road trip, start to finish.”

The album captures the sweat, groove, and urgency of Sullivan and his band’s live shows. Each track began with the band playing live in a room together—guitars, bass, and drums locked in—before being distilled into songs that carry their trademark swagger. “If the recording doesn’t carry the same vibe and energy as our live shows, even if it’s a song we’ve yet to play on stage, then it isn’t us,” Sullivan explains.

Crisscrossing Michigan’s highways, Sullivan and his band have lit up stages from Detroit to Grand Rapids, Kalamazoo to Ann Arbor, with Lansing as their home base. Along the way, with opening dates for national acts including Sponge, Ally Venable, and Pat Travers, they’ve earned a reputation as rock ‘n’ roll hype men who live for the opportunity to kick off the night and turn the atmosphere from house music and chatter to a room of rock ‘n’ rollers all groovin’ together.

Rock and Roll Will Save Us All will be released **November 7, 2025** in multiple formats, including vinyl, CD, cassette, and digital streaming. Lead singles include "Cry For More," and "Eyes Glued to the Pavement," and "99 Degrees."

"This record is about urgency, about living now," Sullivan says. "If we can help someone escape the grind, even just for an evening, then we've done our job."

With *Rock and Roll Will Save Us All*, Sullivan looks to continue to carry his sound to Michigan stages and beyond, celebrating rock 'n' roll with new audiences wherever they may be.
